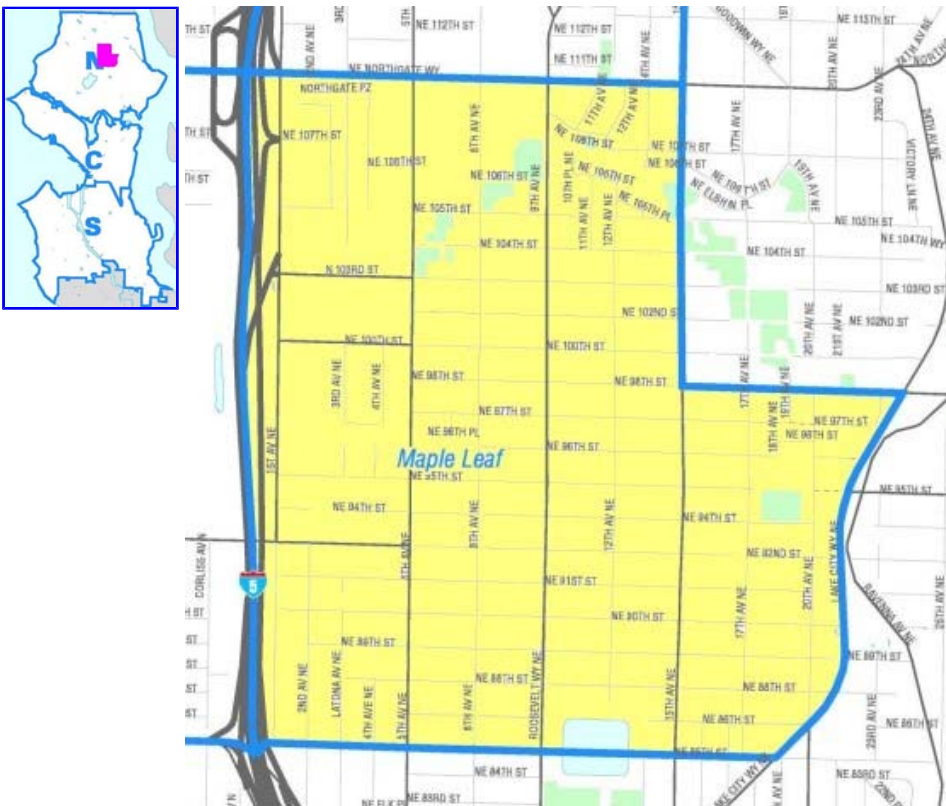

Seattle City Clerk's Neighborhood Map Atlas

The Seattle City Clerk's Office Neighborhood Map Atlas is designed for subject indexing of legislation, photographs, and other documents in the City Clerk's Office and Seattle Municipal Archives. It provides a way to increase consistency in the way geographic names are used and to allow precise retrieval of documents concerning neighborhood districts. It is not designed or intended as an "official" City of Seattle neighborhood map.

For the neighborhood map, the bylaws define the boundaries at NE 75th on the south, along Banner Way to I-5 and then up I-5 on the west, Lake City Way on the east, and from I-5 eastward along NE 103rd Street to 5th Avenue, then north on 5th to Northgate Way, then east on Northgate Way to Roosevelt Way, then south on Roosevelt back to NE 103rd, then east on NE 103rd to the Thornton Creek ravine then along the south side of the ravine to Lake City Way. (When the Northgate Comp Plan was adopted, some residents in Victory Heights were adamantly opposed to an "urban trail" running on the public land adjacent to Thornton Creek. They took over the VH community council and re-drew their community boundaries which had ended north of the ravine and extended them south of the ravine to NE 95th. VH runs west to 15th NE.) The ML boundaries did only go to 103rd on the north. When the NG library and community center were going to be sited on 5th and 107th-ish, Mike T proposed extending the ML boundaries in that rectangle between 5th & Roosevelt with the hope that the new facilities would be named "Maple Leaf" not "Northgate."
