David,

The drawings contain symbols which are a simple, somewhat scaled, graphic depiction of a tree location. We created different symbols that would be easier for a contractor to distinguish between trees to be removed vs. protected. The drawings also include a table which associates each tree on the site by a unique tree id#, as well as required information by the City of Seattle Director's Rule 6:2001, such as species, caliper and canopy size. The information in this table is derived from the original survey and arborist report.

The original report, from Robert W. Williams, provided us with more detailed data at which our drawings were based upon. This information, while not necessary for construction documents, includes the unique tree id#, species, tree diameter (measured at 4.5'), crown spread (average extension of limbs to drip line), height (distance from the base of the tree to the highest point) as well as other information such as Champion Points, health, structural condition, survivability, and hazard potential.

I hope this provides you with the information you were looking for concerning the tree drawings.
